AGILITY GATE APP – Code 2468

With the app you can go to a class and check-in, scratch, let the gate know you are FEO or that you have a conflict. When the class is running you can see who is running in the ring. The running order will update automatically as dogs are checked in, when they run, etc. You can stay in your set-up and keep an eye on the running order to see when you are due up. This will keep groups of people from congregating around the gate and help with social distancing. Open and Novice people can see what classes are running to have a better idea how the show is running. Go to the app store that you download your apps from to download it.

MOVE-UPS

All pre-show move ups must be received by **6pm, Monday, May 12**. The AKC requires move-ups to be in writing. You may send an email for a move-up to Brenda at agilesam@gmail.com with your name, your dog's call name, the name & date of the trial and what class you want the dog to be moved to. If you miss the deadline for move-ups, you may move your dog up the first day of the show for any **subsequent** days even if you are not showing a dog that day. In addition, a friend may do the move-up for you if you are not there. However, you may not move up the day of the show for that day.

There will be day-to-day move-ups at the show provided the Trial Secretary receives them within 15 minutes after the end of the last class. There will be no move-ups in the morning before the start of the trial.

However, a dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions: The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from the Novice

"A" class to the Novice "B" class.

DIRECTIONS to Galway Downs, 38801 Corralitos Rd, Temecula, CA 92592

From the I-15 exit CA-79S (Temecula Pkwy)
Go East 5.8 miles
Turn left onto Los Caballos Rd
Turn right onto Los Corralitos Rd
Continue on Los Corralitos Rd to the **Equestrian Events Entrance - Gate code #9999**
Turn left through the gate and then take the first right
Follow the signs to Pauba field.

OR

Take CA-79S to Pauba Rd.
Turn left on Pauba Rd
Turn left on Los Corralitos Rd
At the **Equestrian Events Entrance - Gate code #9999** turn right.
Take the first right after the gate and follow the signs to Pauba field.

SET UP AND SECURITY:

MEASURING:

The judge is not a VMO, but we have an exhibitor that is a VMO and can measure dogs for an official height card between classes. If your dog needs to be measured it must be done before your run.
