We have a **wait list for Saturday & Sunday!** If you pull your dog for any reason, and there is someone to take your place, you will receive a full refund for the class(es) you pull. NOTE ON MAPS: Exhibitor maps for the day will be sent by 6 AM via email the morning of the trial and will be available on the Agility Gate App. They will also be posted on the trailer that morning. Printed maps will not be available at the trail.

MOVE-UPS

All pre-show move-ups or lateral moves must be received **by 6 PM, Monday, July 6**. The AKC requires move-ups/lateral moves to be in writing. You may send an email for a move-up or lateral move to Brenda at agilesam@gmail.com with your name, your dog's call name, the name and date of the trial and what class you want the dog moved to. If you miss the deadline for move-ups, you may move your dog up on the first day of the show for any subsequent days even if you are not showing a dog that day. A friend may do the move-up for you if you are not there. You may NOT move up the day of the show for that day.

There will be day-to-day lateral moves and move-ups at the show, provided the Trial Secretary receives the move within 15 minutes after the end of the last class. There will be no moves on the morning before the start of the trial.

However, a dog which has been entered in a Novice “A” class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler, may be moved to the Novice “B” class under the following conditions:

- The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.
- The request must state the reason and justification for the move from the Novice “A” to the Novice “B”.

DIRECTIONS TO GEORGE INGALLS EQUESTRIAN CENTER:

Address for GPS: The George Ingalls Equestrian Center main entrance is just past the Norco Animal Control Center at 98 Sixth St., Norco, CA 92860. Use this address to be directed towards the main entrance and the first arena.

From the 91/I-15 Northbound – Exit Sixth Street and turn right. Go past Pike’s Peak Park. The site is at the top of the hill – approximately 2 miles from the freeway. We are in the first arena.

From the I-15 Southbound - Exit Sixth Street and turn left. Go past Pike’s Peak Park. The site is at the top of the hill – approximately 2 miles from the freeway. We are in the first arena.

OVERNIGHT RV PARKING

RV spaces with electrical hook-up are available. RV spots with electric hook up is \$55/night for 50 amp, \$45/night for 30 amp and \$35 for 20 amp. Dry camping is \$14. Contact Brenda at agilesam@gmail.com or 951-813-8667 for RV parking.

SET-UP & SECURITY

Set-up is on Friday morning around 11:30 AM. If you would like to help unload the trailer and set up the rings, please meet the course builders at 11:30. All others may set up after 3 PM.

There is no security guard -- leave things at your own risk.

MEASURING

Our judge this weekend is not a VMO. If your dog needs to be measured, he will be measuring for this trial only. You must have your dog measured **before** you run if they don’t have a height card.
