MOVE-UPS

All pre-show move ups and lateral moves must be received by **6pm, Monday, Sept 21**. The AKC requires move-ups/lateral moves to be in writing. You may send an email for a move-up or lateral move to Brenda at agilesam@gmail.com with your name, your dog's call name, the name & date of the trial and what class you want the dog to be moved to. If you miss the deadline for move-ups/lateral moves, you may move your dog up or lateral the first day of the show for any **subsequent** days even if you are not showing a dog that day. In addition, a friend may do this for you if you are not there. However, you may not move up/lateral move the day of the show for that day.

There will be day-to-day move-ups at the show provided the Trial Secretary receives them within 15 minutes after the end of the last class. There will be no moves on the morning before the start of the trial.

However, a dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions: The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from the Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class.

DIRECTIONS to Vista Palomar Riders, 973 Little Gopher Canyon Rd., Vista, CA 92084

Traveling from San Diego:

From the I-15 North take exit 41 - Gopher Canyon Rd.

Turn left (West) onto Gopher Canyon Rd.

Turn right onto Little Gopher Canyon Rd.

Destination is 1.3 miles on your left.

Traveling from Orange County:

Take I-5 South towards San Diego.

Take Exit 54A onto CA-76 East.

Turn left onto Old River Road.

Turn right onto Little Gopher Canyon Rd.

Destination is on the right.

SET UP AND SECURITY:

We are setting up the rings on Friday afternoon. If you would like to come and help set up, you must contact Brenda. Only set up crew will be allowed to set their stuff up. This is a private facility. We do not have security. Leave belongings at your own risk.

MEASURING:

The judge is not a VMO. He will be measuring dogs for this trial only between classes. If your dog needs to be measured it must be done before your run.

Directions to Vet: Go left onto Gopher Canyon Rd. Turn right to merge onto I-15 South. In 9 mi take exit 32 to merge onto CA 78 towards Oceanside. Take exit 15 onto Nordahl Rd. and turn right. In 400 ft turn right onto Montiel Rd. In 500 ft 2055 Monteil Rd is on the Right.

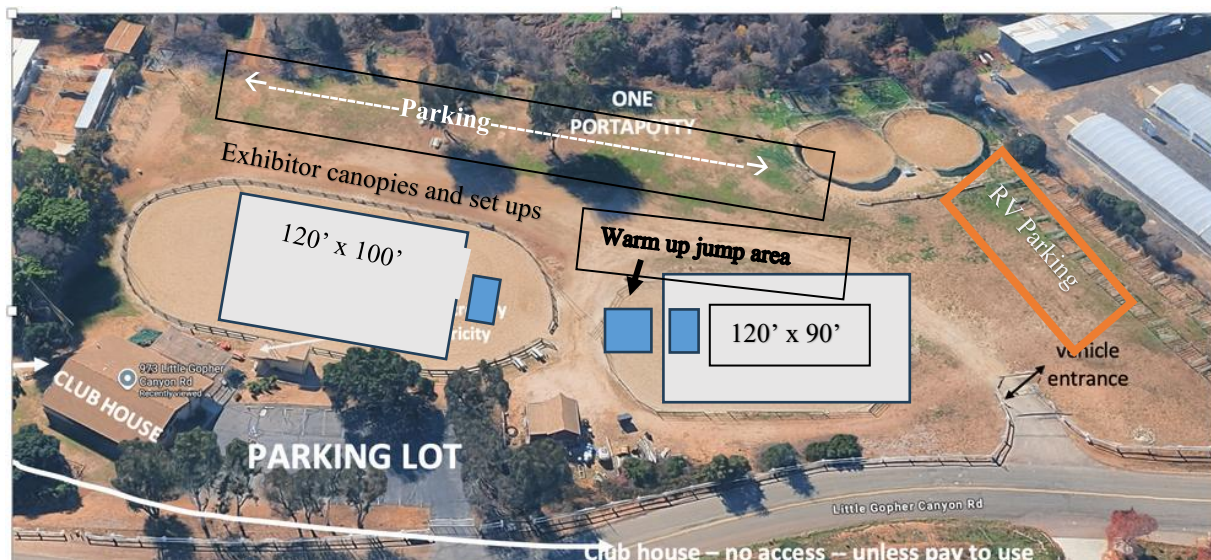
